

Report of the Exclusive Power Seminar on “Empowerment of Education in a Post Pandemic World” at Rangia College, Assam

Rangia, 4 June 2020

A seminar on “Empowerment of Education in a Post Pandemic World” was organized on 4th June 2020 by IQAC, Rangia College in collaboration with ICT Academy, Bangaluru, India. The invited resource persons were:

The seminar was inaugurated by Dr. Brajendra Saikia, Principal, Rangia College. In his inaugural speech, he talked about how the world has been compelled to change its normal way of life due to COVID 19. He highlighted the general concerns of the student community. The students are facing a situation that is totally alien to them. He went on to say that even the normal mode of the teaching procedure has been interrupted. He raised important questions like, what will be the new mode of teaching and learning in education. How will the students of a rural-based college like us adapt to the situation? What precautions should the students take to be safe and secure?

The resource persons’ deliberations were motivational and thought-provoking. They elaborately explained the situation that the students may face in the post COVID world. They pointed out that this new situation also brings in many opportunities for the teaching and learning process. Learning has become easier because of the emergence of new digital platforms of communication.
